

BOTTRILL FAMILY - Northamptonshire

Aimeric Boterel bastard 1070? of **Geoffrey Boterel I**

1100 Henry I gave him at coronation 5 hides of land Abington, Northants, which had previously belonged to Earl Stephen, brother of Geoffrey Boterel I

Thomas Botereus b. 1234 on the Whilton tax payers list in 1301. From Aston Boterell

30.4.1327 William Botrel of Whilton indicted for felony. Escaped from Northampton and assaulted king's sheriff.

Hugh Boterel - 30 Oct 1328 [of Tyffeld [Tiffield [Northamptonshire]?]; priest. Great nephew of Thomas Botereus.

John Boterel

- 27 Nov 1344. Feoffment of reversion of lands in Maidford, Nths "lately in the possession of John Boterel and Alice his wife. (ref. NPL2111)

William Botterell

living at Whilton – got charter of lands and tenements in Norton 1409 from Thomas Giles

John Boterell of Herleston, 26 June 1 Hen VI [1423] to deliver seizin of a messuage and land c.p. in Harlestone' to John Treves.

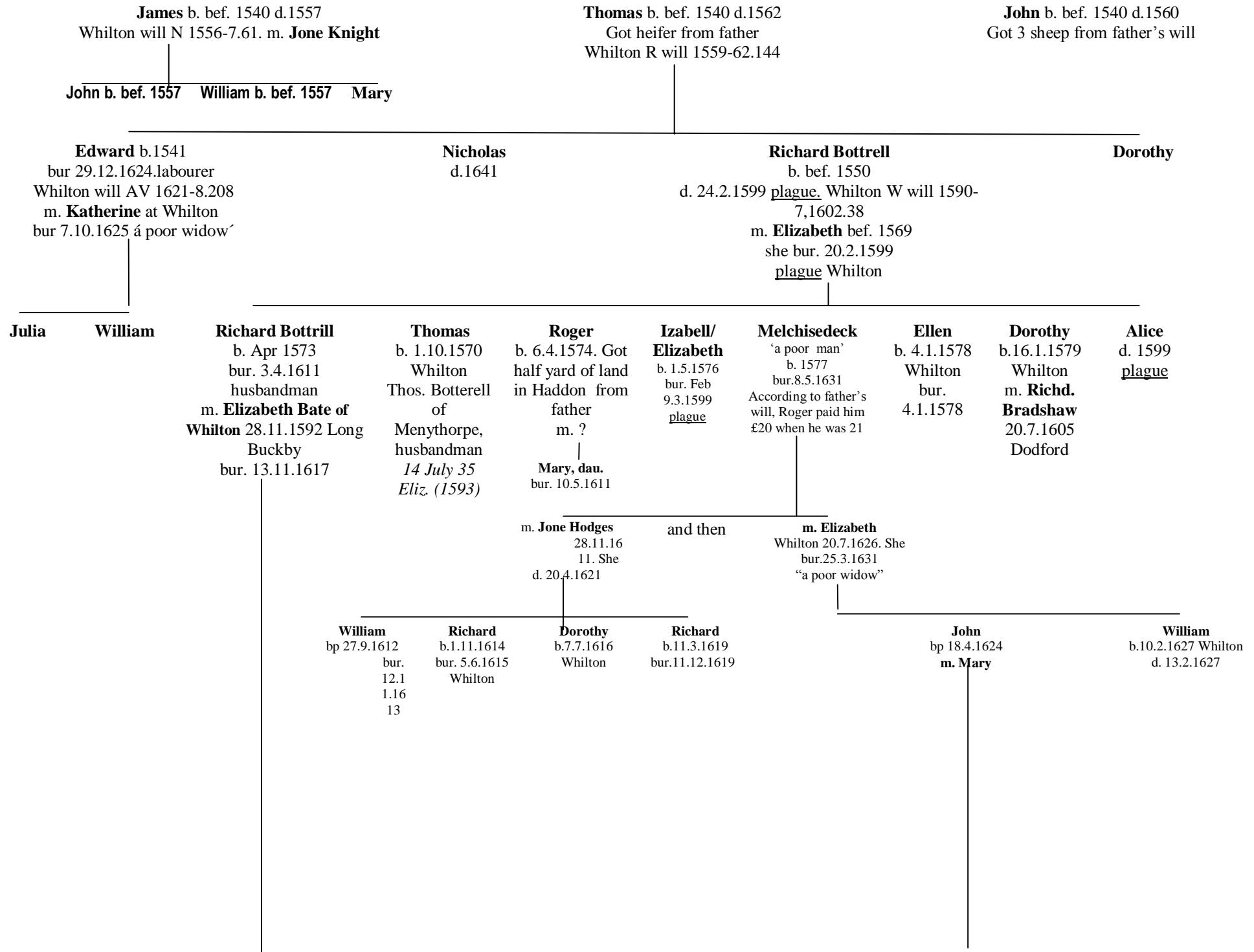

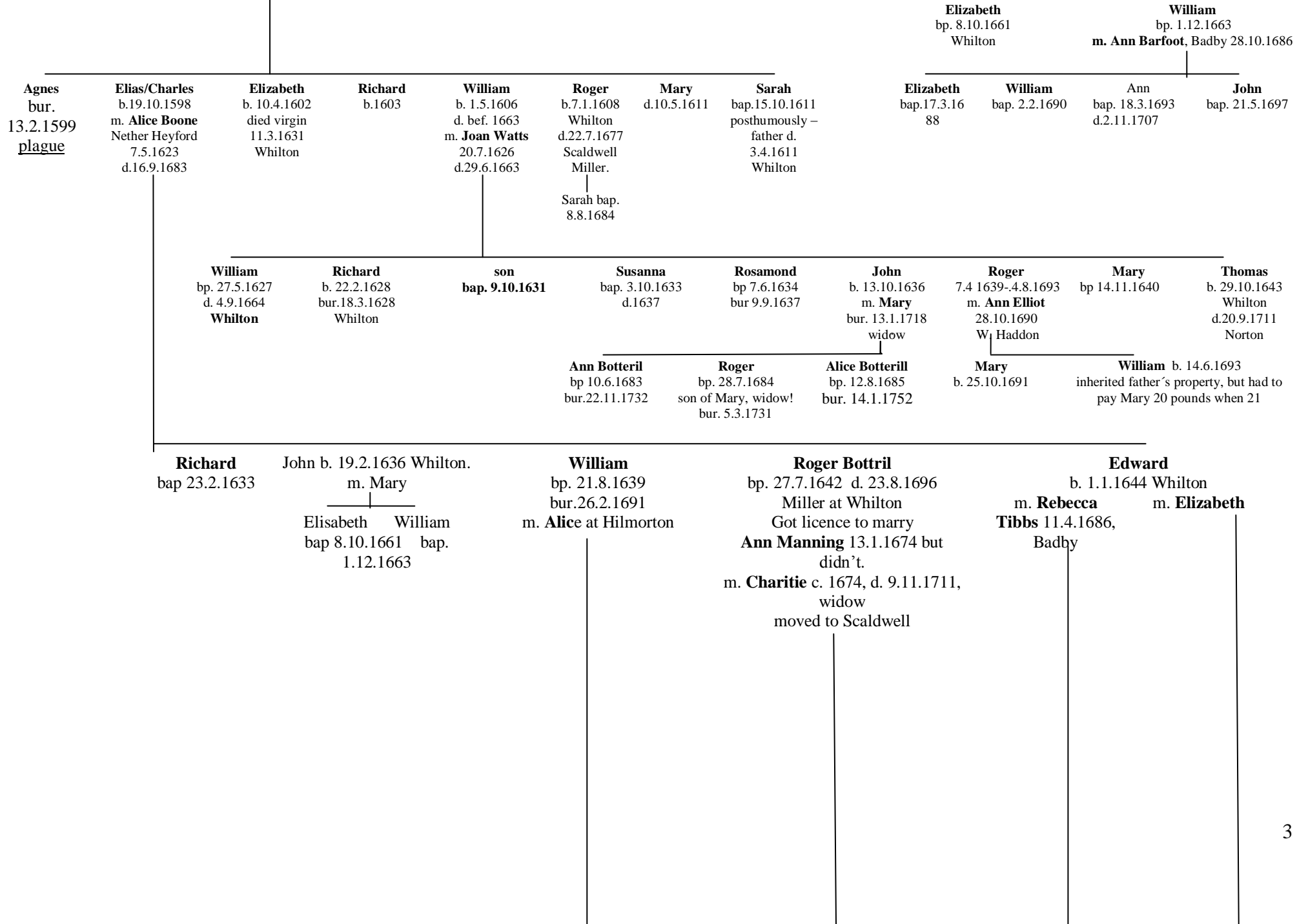

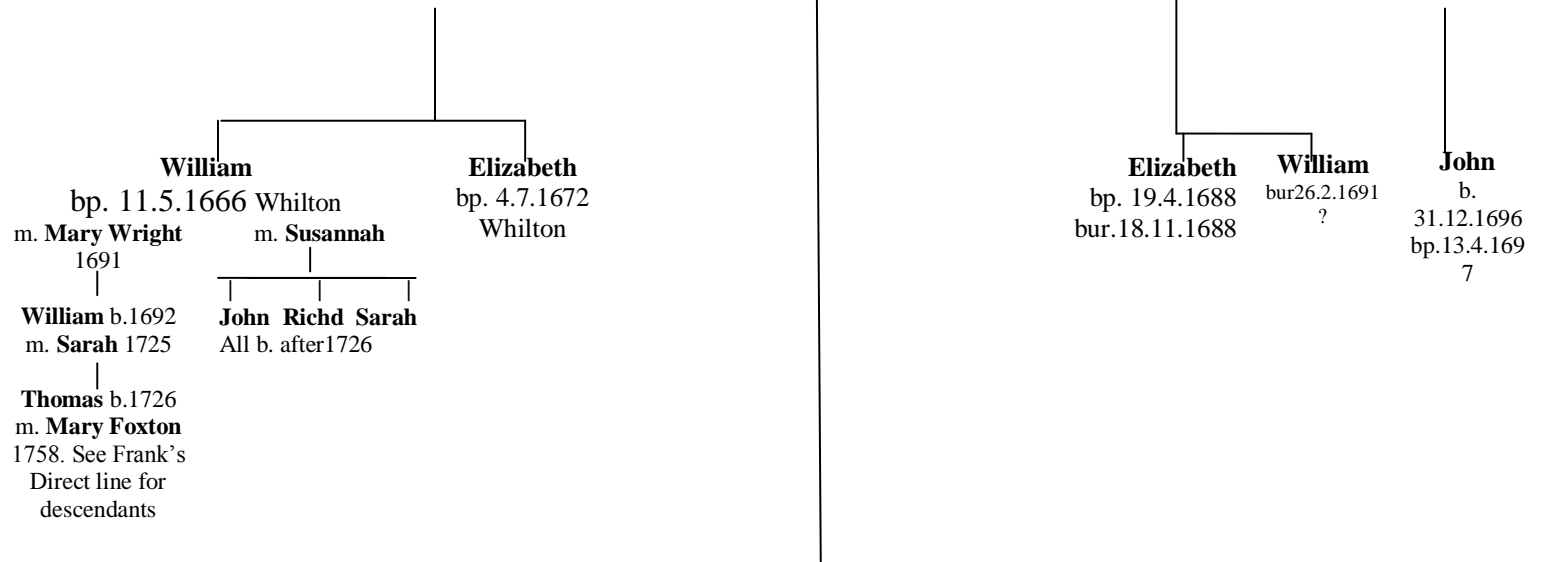
